Pinnacle Alloys ER317/317L AWS CLASS ER317, ER317L CODE AND SPECIFICATION DATA: AWS A5.9 ASME SFA 5.9; UNS S31780, S31783

DESCRIPTION:

Pinnacle Alloys ER317L has a nominal composition (wt.-%) of 19.5 Cr, 14 Ni, 3.5 Mo, with a carbon content restricted to 0.03 maximum. This low carbon material reduces the possibility of intergranular carbide precipitation. This increases the resistance to intergranular corrosion without the use of stabilizers, such as niobium or titanium. Strength of this low-carbon alloy however, is less than that of the niobium-stabilized alloys or Type 317 at elevated temperatures. Pinnacle Alloys ER317L is well suited for applications in the paper industries, food processing facilities, chemical processing plants, and marine environments.
