Pinnacle Alloys ER420 AWS CLASS ER420 CODE AND SPECIFICATION DATA: AWS A5.9 ASME SFA 5.9; UNS S42080

DESCRIPTION:

Pinnacle Alloys ER420 has a nominal composition (wt.-%) of 13 Cr and 0.38 C. ER420 is used for many surfacing operations requiring corrosion resistance and resistance to abrasion. It has somewhat higher hardness than weld metals deposited by ER410 electrodes. This increases wear resistance. Pinnacle Alloys ER420 requires preheat and interpass temperatures of 400°F followed by slow cooling. PWHT is used to temper the weld deposit.
